


“See!”

As we come to the Parsha Re'eh we are entering into the month of Elul!! Elul is the sixth month on the Hebrew calendar, the last month before the season of Awe and Repentance marked by the High Holy days of Rosh Hashanah—the “New Year”, and Yom Kippur. It is a time of reflection and seeking God with a heart of repentance. At the same time there is a great and heightened joy in being near the Beloved, which is reflected in the name of the month. “Elul” is written with four Hebrew letters that are seen as an acronym of the verse in Song of Songs, “I am my beloved’s and my beloved is mine.”

Elul is also a month where it is said that “The King is in the fields”. As we seek God we can expect to “find” Him nearby and in everyday encounters. As He reveals Himself and shows us perhaps some lessons or revelations that He might want us to see as we reflect on the past year and get ready to enter the new year expectantly. Before the great coronation of the King and the Fall Feasts, the month of Elul is a time to meet our beloved King and Messiah Yeshua “as we are”. May we clearly see a vision of how we can serve Him and love Him and welcome Him into every aspect of our being. Behold! He stands at the door and knocks (Rev 3:20)! Once we choose to open the door and follow Him, nothing can separate us from His great love!
