

## “Holy Ones”

You shall be holy, for I, the LORD your God, am holy.  
Leviticus 19:2



Holiness and Love go together! Holiness is living by the codes of the Kingdom, and the ordinances of the King— in Love, as a separated people unto Him. We are to be holy as He is holy, one with God in heart and mind.

This parsha is right in the middle of the book of Leviticus, and contains central teachings of which all the Torah is centered around including the commandment to Love our neighbor as ourselves, and the above verse: Be holy for I, the LORD your God, am Holy. Amazingly, the commandment to be holy is given not to just leaders or the one high priest this time, it is spoken by God through Moses to all the children of Israel. It is spoken for all His children. It is for the whole body of Messiah. Together we can attain it! And how do we do that? Yeshua teaches us all the commandments point to loving God with all our hearts and all our souls and all our might, and loving our neighbor as ourselves. We can do all the right commandments, but without Love, they are nothing. May we remember that it is He who loved us first! His love is so great, and so too may we lavish ours upon Him through our praise and prayer and worship today. May our children be Holy and may they be loving in obedience to Messiah Yeshua. Precisely!! Be holy because the Lord is holy. Be perfect because our Father in heaven is perfect.
