Towards the last part of this parsha, after the sin of the spies, God gives the commandment for every household to take a portion of their dough as an offering to Him when they enter the land of Israel. This portion that is taken is called “challah” given as a reminder that all that we have comes from Him and we are to give the first portion to Him from all we do. On a personal note, I love making challah for Shabbat, so when we read this parsha with the mention of challah in the Torah, I get excited every time we come up to it! The *mitzvah* of challah is also connected to blessing our home and household.

On Friday morning I got a line message from my daughter who is away at college. She wrote, Mom, please could you send me bread! It was like a miracle that the message came on the Friday morning of this Shabbat of Shelach Lecha! God answered a prayer doubly.
