“Noah (rest)”

Genesis 6:9~11:32

These are the genealogies of Noah. Noah was a righteous man. He was blameless among his generation. Noah continually walked with God.

Genesis 6:9



Noah was the only righteous man who walked on the earth in his generation. Noah's name means `rest`. God saw that the earth was ruined and all humanity corrupted, and told Noah His plan to destroy the earth with a flood. He gave Noah instructions to build an ark. God kept Noah and his family safe and buoyed up in the ark as the flood waters covered the earth. Thankfully, God promised that He will not destroy the world again through a flood, and He put His rainbow in the sky as a sign of the covenant between Him and the land and the people.

Praise God! He is a Saving God, He is a God of Hope! The gift of Salvation is given through Yeshua's atoning sacrifice for all mankind. He says `Come to me and I will give you rest`. Yet we still need to stay ready and alert, as Yeshua says that at the coming of the Son of Man, again it will be just as the days of Noah with people "eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage", and like in those days the people will not understand until the flood came. May we set out in prayer time today in readiness and alert to walk in ways that are pleasing to Him. Let us seek Him for our "instructions". Give thanks for His Saving Grace! Delight in the colors of the rainbow that He paints a-new in each day, expressing His creation and sustaining us in Love. As we continue reading from the book of Genesis this week, may we put all our hope and all our faith in the word of God! Pray for the Salvation of all our families and loved ones and all of Israel (Yeshua means Salvation)! Be thankful in all things and walk faithfully in His ways--we are the righteousness of God in our Messiah Yeshua!


The Holy One of Israel is’s Redeemer. He will be called God of all the earth. Isaiah 54:5
