Then Miriam the prophetess, Aaron’s sister, took a timbrel in her hand, and all the women went out after her in dance with timbrels. And Miriam chanted for them: Sing to the LORD, for He has triumphed gloriously; Horse and driver He has hurled into the sea. Exodus 15:20~21



Being set free is reason for song!! This parsha, including the Haftarah (the song of Deborah), is full of song. This Shabbat is called Shabbat *Shirah*, the Sabbath of song! The Israelites sing the song of Moses, a song of Praise and exaltation, as Miriam leads the women with timbrels in dance. Our God made the Sea part! He shows the world that He is God and in full control of all his creation, and He shows the children of Israel that He is their God and that He will provide for their every need. He sends down manna from heaven, a double portion for Shabbat. He brings water from a rock for their thirst. They grumble but despite that He lovingly provides.

One day He shows us that Yeshua is the Bread of Life, the true bread from heaven. And that all who believe have eternal life (John 6:47). He is the Living Water. He is the LORD who heals us (Exodus 15:26). Take of the bread, which represents His body, and eat (Matthew 26:26)! Sing the Song of the Lamb! May we sing a new song to the Lord, glorify Him through our praise and live lives of worship. May we trust in Him to provide and to guide. Let’s keep on praying and singing through our wilderness times and in all times. The LORD is our strength and our song! No one who trusts in Him will ever hunger or thirst!!
