Every week on our prayer sheet we start with Praise and then move to Confession and Thanksgiving. One of the offerings mentioned in the parsha is the Thanks offering. Thanks is "Todah" in Hebrew. It is an expression of whole hearted and even whole bodied praise and thanksgiving. Did you know that even a wave of the hand towards heaven has an effect in the heavenliness and can make a change in the atmosphere by driving out the occupant!! That is a little introduction to movement in worship for you!!

May we offer our prayers today by entering His gates with our whole hearts of Thanksgiving and entering His courts with our arms waving up in a joyous movement of Praise. We and our families belong to you LORD!!
