

# Tazria תזריע

“She bears seed”

Leviticus 12:1~13:59

2Kings 4:42~5:19

Matthew 8:1~4, Luke 2:21~33

1Peter 2:1~2

This is the Torah for her who gives birth, whether to a male or a female child.  
Leviticus 12:7c



The parsha begins with the purity laws for a mother who is giving birth. It is interesting to note Yeshua's mother Miriam kept the period of purification after childbirth, according to the Torah (Luke 2:22~24). We were excited by that to connect how obedient the parents of our Messiah, who is the Word made flesh, were to faithfully observe the Torah!

The next chapter is about the defiling skin disease known as `tza`arat` which also manifests on houses and clothing materials. The determination of `clean` or `unclean` is made by the Priest, who looks at all the different cases as detailed in Lev. Chapter 13.

We ask God to look into our hearts to see where we have unconfessed sin, so that we can come to Him with a pure heart in this season of preparation before Passover. We are already clean because of the word He has spoken to us, but we must continually keep His words within our heart and guard our heart diligently. May our words be words of life.

As God does not give up on us, we too must not give up on working through the precious relationships in our families and lives!! We learn week after week that it takes time. May our thanksgiving overflow to the Holy Spirit who comes to us through being born again in Yeshua. May all our loved ones receive new life in Yeshua and be set free!
