

“Say”

Speak to *Bnei-Yisrael*, and say to them: These are the appointed *moadim* of ADONAI, which you are to proclaim to be holy convocations—My *moadim*. Leviticus 23:2



I love Leviticus 23 where we find the *Moadim*! And the commandment to celebrate the appointed times of the LORD, starting with Shabbat. May we recognize the special and appointed times, *moadim* (word pictured above!), that God set in His eternal plan and may we sanctify the time of our life to Him. His plan is for peace and wholeness, to restore us to His “shalom”. May we receive the gift of His peace from our *Sar Shalom*, Prince of Peace, Yeshua, as we walk as He walked~ in His ways and keeping His appointed days!

We read this parsha in the healing month of Iyyar, as we are counting up the days of the Omer from Passover to Shavuot. Remembering and re-living when the children of Israel were getting ready to receive the revelation of the Torah at Mt. Sinai, the covenant that is considered as a “ketubah”, or marriage contract between God and His people.

It is said in Jewish tradition that the tablets the Ten Commandments were written on were made from Sapphire stone from the throne room of Heaven! Its a beautiful image, even if we may not know for sure until He reveals all things to us! Meanwhile, may we drink from the Living Water of His precious word, and keep drawing nearer to our Beloved, Yeshua, ready to receive His revelation a-new here on earth, and be filled with His Holy Spirit with an ever fresh anointing! May we re-new our vows in preparation and in unity as His bride, and treasure each day expectantly as we count!
