Praise God for He is our righteous God. Justice! Justice! In Hebrew, “Tzedek, tzedek!”, reads the verse above in Deuteronomy 16:20. The word bears repeating as we are to be diligent to pursue justice. His Torah is the Torah of truth.

In this parsha Moses tells the children of Israel that another prophet after him is promised by the LORD from among their brothers, who will speak only the words of the LORD.
